## INDIGENOUS SEXUAL HEALTH PROGRAM

This is a health promotion team which offers a wide range of educational, preventative, training, care and support services for individuals and communities affected by sexually transmissible infections (including HIV/AIDS) and other sexual health concerns. However, in recognition that no health issue within the indigenous community can be addressed in isolation, this team is committed to working with people in a wide range of health and social matters such as drug and alcohol, diabetes, heart disease, domestic and sexual violence, maternal and child welfare. The services provided by this team include:

- Emotional & social support for persons infected and affected by HIV/AIDS, other sexually transmissible infections and Hepatitis C;
- Information, advice and referral for individuals and groups re sexual health issues;
- Development of resource materials for communities;
- Education and training for health professionals (including indigenous health workers), welfare and community workers, youth workers, and any persons working with the indigenous community;
- Education and health promotion activities for individuals, community groups, councils, organizations and schools re sexual health issues;
- Development of clinical outreach screening programs to members of the indigenous community to ensure better access to basic primary health care.
- Telephone advice;
- Contact tracing for other medical services.
